

Senior Tax Exemptions and Senior Tax Freeze



A new law was passed this year regarding senior exemptions. It states that ALL seniors must apply annually. This includes seniors that have received the senior exemption in the past.

New Applicants

(Must be 65 yrs and you lived at Cedarwood on January 1, 2010)

What you need to do:

You must apply at the Rich Township Assessor's Office located at :

You will need to bring:

- A copy of Membership Certificate or Occupancy Agreement
- A copy of the tax bill
- Proof of age (Driver's License or State ID)

Existing Applicants

(Must be 65 yrs and lived at Cedarwood on January 1, 2010)

What you need to do:

Since the forms have been simplified, all you need to do is:

Senior Tax Exemption

- Fill out the form
- Sign it
- Mail it by March 3, 2011

Senior Tax Freeze

- Fill out form using 2009 income information
- Form must be notarized
- Form must be signed in the presence of the notary

For questions or notary services, you can stop by the office on:
Wednesday, February 23, 2011 between 9-1p.m.
Wednesday, March 2, 2011 between 9-1p.m.

Senior Freeze

To qualify for the taxable year 2010, you must meet the following requirements:

- Year of Birth must be on or before 1945
- Total gross household income must be less than \$55,000 for the year 2009
- You were a member of Cedarwood on or before January 1, 2009 and resided in Cedarwood for the entire year
